To vote at the NBPSs on the polling day, electors are required to present the original copy of their Hong Kong Identity Cards or any of the following specified alternative documents, including:

- (a) the original of a valid Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (“HKSAR”) Passport; or
- (b) the original of Certificate of Exemption; or
- (c) the original of an acknowledgement of application for the HKID card; or
- (d) the original of the person’s valid seaman’s identity book; or
- (e) the original of the person’s valid document of identity for visa purposes; or
- (f) a document evidencing a report to a police officer of the loss or destruction of the person’s HKID card or the Certificate of Exemption or the acknowledgement of application for the HKID card (commonly referred to as “a memo of lost property”), together with the original of a valid passport or similar travel document (e.g. a passport other than the HKSAR Passport or the Home Return Permit) showing his/her name and photograph.

** the British National (Overseas) (BN(O)) passport is not a valid travel document or proof of identity*
